The unwarranted invasion of Ukraine by Russia continues and the need for humanitarian aid and relief by its people remains critical. The relentless bombardment of cities causing destruction of infrastructure, buildings, and homes as well as serious injury to warriors, women, and children and loss of life, brings with it fear, despair, and suffering for the Ukrainian nation.

In response to this, in January of 2024, the four Eparchies of the Ukrainian Catholic Church in the United States established the **Healing of Wounds of the War in Ukraine Fund (HWF)**. This Fund is a continuation of the legacy of the **Metropolia Humanitarian Aid Fund** initiated at the onset of the war in 2022, distributing over \$7.2 million in aid since then. It supported 103 projects helping internally displaced persons and refugees, providing medical aid and emergency food assistance, supporting military and hospital chaplains, as well as strengthening supply chains for humanitarian aid provided by other agencies.

The **Healing of Wounds Fund** is a new phase of this foundation that continues to work on its original mission with a particular focus on the healing of physical, emotional, and spiritual wounds inflicted by the criminal Russian invasion. The Fund seeks to respond quickly to urgent needs of its beneficiaries, in this way showing solidarity and Christian love to our brothers and sisters in Ukraine and internationally. Support goes to the areas of greatest need ensuring that every donation is used responsibly for the wounded warriors, children, families, and communities it serves.

As the **Fundraising Committee of St. Nicholas Ukrainian Catholic Church in Watervliet, NY** begins its annual **Fall Fundraising Initiative on November 1, 2025** we ask that you join us in supporting the great efforts of the Metropolia Humanitarian Aid Fund in its new phase.
